Starring Aaron Kwok, Carmen Lee, Samo Hung

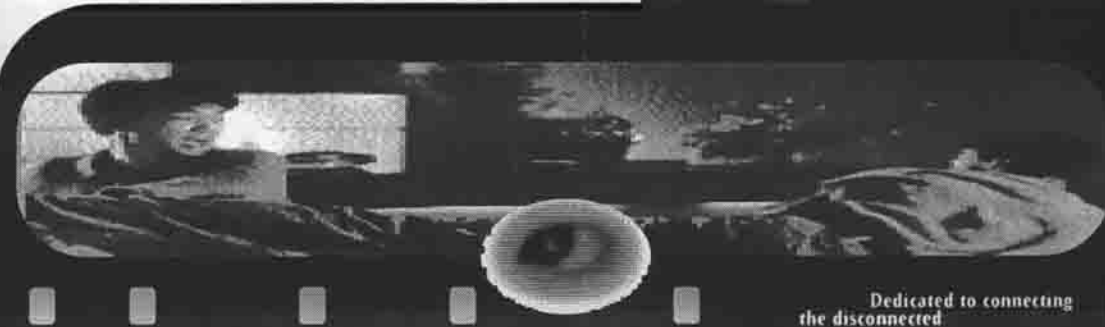
